Scholarship Guidelines

1. OYBC scholarships are to help young people who are interested in birds to attend summer camps, workshops, classes, training programs, conventions, and other bird-related activities. Funds for these scholarships come from our partners, private donations, and proceeds from special fund raising events.
2. All applications must be accompanied by a 500 words, (or fewer), essay describing why you want to attend this event/class and how you feel this experience will make you a better birder.
3. Application must be signed by a parent or guardian.
4. Applications are reviewed quarterly, application submissions must be made at least four months in advance of the class/workshop.
5. Recipients will be notified in writing.
